About the Job

Youth Intervention Specialists work in small groups of 5-10 youth to give individual assistance to students that are below academic standards for their grade level. They work hand in hand with teachers, administrators, parents and the Expanded Learning Director to provide specific curriculum and a road map to success in math, reading and writing to close the academic gap for each individual student.
