

Project Challenge

Origami Projects to keep you entertained; Yacht



Suggested Grades: 1st-5th Grade

In today's activity, we are going to make our own yacht!

A little Help for the parents:

Materials List

Help your child gather materials to make this activity.

- paper/ colored or white
- Scissors
- markers

Steps to Success

Follow these steps to help your child succeed.

Step 1: Begin with a square sheet of origami paper with color side down. If you only have regular 8.5x11 paper, follow these instructions to turn it into a square.

Step 2: Fold diagonally in half taking the upper left corner and bringing it over to the bottom right corner.

Step 3: Take the bottom right corner and fold it left aligning the edges.

Step 4: Take a part of the bottom and simply fold it up like you see in the image. No need to rent a yacht when you can make one!
